Kids Giving Back programs emphasise connecting with communities to whom participants are giving back: the homeless, individuals in need, refugees/asylum seekers, the aged.

Cook4Good - half day

Participants cook several hundred meals at Our Big Kitchen (OBK), a community kitchen in Bondi, followed by making deliveries to homeless shelters and cafes/community centres for the homeless. *Kids Giving Back* organises all recipient organisations.

Cost: \$90 + GST/pp MINIMUM 20 PARTICIPANTS – lunch included

Please note – our program rates do not include transportation.

Cook4Good + Urban Walk - day long program

Cook4Good as per above. Participants leave OBK with several hundred meals that they deliver to Rough Edges, Darlinghurst, a café and community centre for the homeless community. Led by a Rough Edges patron (client) together with their education coordinator, participants then proceed on a Rough Edges Urban Walk, exploring the streets of Kings Cross from an insider's perspective. The Urban Walk is highly interactive and discussion takes place throughout. To read more

Cost: \$105 + GST/head MINIMUM 20 PARTICIPANTS – lunch included

Max. per Urban Walk group 20. Larger numbers will be split into 2 groups.

NB: If you would like to bring children 14+ please talk to us about a content-modified, age appropriate Urban Walk.

Cook4Good: Melting Pot – program is a bit longer than a half day

Cook4Good takes place at OBK (Bondi) where participants make meals together with refugee chefs who teach them delicious meals from their culture. The morning also features a discussion about refugees and asylum seekers, the challenges they face, and their integration into their new home country. Participants then sit with the chefs and enjoy the delicious cuisine of various nationalities. The majority of meals cooked are donated to the refugee community.

Cost: \$100 + GST/pp – adults MINIMUM 20 PARTICIPANTS – lunch included

Scones4Good – half day

An intergenerational program that breaks the isolation experienced by many older people.

Participants make scones, followed by a tea party that they host at an aged care facility either close by OBK (Bondi) or in an area of your choice. *Scones4Good* is a highly interactive experience that brings joy and huge warm smiles to participants of all generations.

Cost: \$50 + GST/pp – MINIMUM 20 PARTICIPANTS

Food Clothing Shelter – half day

Food Clothing Shelter takes place at Thread Together in Banksmeadow (near Eastgardens).

The program gives participants a practical understanding of the basic needs that a growing number of people in our society (including children and teens) are unable to take for granted. While these needs are considered basic, their availability is in fact out of reach for so many.

Participants will work to provide the basic elements for members of communities in need: this includes sorting clothes, preparing and packaging and possible delivery of much needed items.

Cost: \$100 + GST/pp – MINIMUM 20 PARTICIPANTS – lunch included
